Embracing Fractured Stained Glass: Death and Life in Churches

Broadly speaking, individual, mainline churches have seen a decline in membership, attendance, and overall giving. There has been much attention given to trying to understand why this decline has happened and how it can be reversed. There has been much less work on how the decline of individual churches may be a function of life-cycle and other factors outside the control of "revival." This presentation will explore the decline of individual congregations from the perspective of mortality: death, even of churches, is the one truly inevitable part of life. It will also discuss ways in which walking with churches who are dying might follow a "hospice model" where meaning-making and memory, past and future, is the end goal. Finally, it will work to describe practical steps clergy, administration, congregation councils, and lay people might take to work toward the goal of a good church death.

Our invited presenter is G. Travis Woodfield, a self-described theological mosaic. He has a BA in Philosophy from the Franciscan University of Steubenville, an MA in Franciscan Studies from St. Bonaventure University, and life experience ranging from fishmonger to admissions counselor to friar to chaplain. As a Carpenter Fellow for Community Engagement, he earned a Masters in Divinity from Wake Forest University in May 2018. While a Demon Deacon, he worked at the Center for Congregational Health, developing a model for congregational hospice care. Oh... and you can ask him to do a magic trick or two!
